**Missions: intercultural exploration of CITY NAME**

0. Choose a name to your team related to **CITY NAME** local context.
  1. Interview at least 3 persons of different profiles who live in **CITY NAME** to find out what they like in living here. In which way do you think their preferences are related to cultural values?
  2. Take a few minutes to observe the city, its stores and the people. What do you find surprising? Observe people and take notes about the difference in their interactions. Discuss your observations within your group.
  3. Search on internet a song related to the city/region. Take a video of you singing your favourite song (from your country).
  4. Find out the origin of the two historical buildings and an anecdote on each tower.
  6. Ask locals which is the most important historical event that happened in the city
