Description

Duration	Instructions
5 min	Distribution of the human bingo cards (ANNEX 1) and introduction of the icebreaker: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The aim is to complete one row across, down or diagonally and call out Bingo. The rows can be two or three according with the time available and the number of participants: - Participants have to interview each other to find the people having the characteristics in the boxes of the human bingo. Once they find one they have to write the name and nationality in the corresponding box. - Participants cannot obtain more than one answer from each participant
20 min	Human bingo : participants trying to get to know each other better through questions linked to diverse cultural background and having a possibility of answering only YES/NO
5 min	Final restitution
